We've taken the footsteps of all the visitors and planted a huge



Your trees will live for around 75-150 years*

(What a legacy!)



They will support over **1 million** mammals, reptiles, birds and amphibians



Your trees will grow to absorb 32 million gallons of water (per year). Which fights flooding, soil erosion and helps regulate our climate



Your trees will grow to sequester around 35,000Kg of carbon per year - the average carbon footprint of 3.5 people in the UK



When they mature, they will create enough oxygen for 497 people. Breathe easy.



They will cover around 2 hectares, the equivalent of 11 5 football fields







In return for joining us, we provide you and your participants regular impact reports that show how many trees you've planted together and the positive impact those trees will have.

You, and your stakeholders, will be able to see the difference you're making.

Every tree your members plant will grow to make a positive impact and will be attributed to your organisation.

In short, you will become a part of the solution.



Our background

To date, as an organisation, Earth Runs CIC have planted over 135,000 trees around the world through the promotion of getting active for Earth.

We've hosted virtual challenges, school schemes, work promotions and produced the first ever biodegradable seeded medals. The 1% Club initiative was introduced at the start of the year, and our members have already planted over 13,000 trees, and it grows month on month.

We partner with well-established tree-planting charities that plant our trees around the world. They support the local communities, help fight poverty (a significant contributor to illegal logging), and ensure a fair wage for the tree-planting team.

We continue to push for 1% of the UK population to plant 11 million trees a month.
